

1. INTRODUCTION

Therefore, we exclusively Process Personal Data (within the meaning of article 4(1) of the General Data Protection Regulation) in compliance with the applicable laws, in particular with the EU-General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”) This Privacy Statement provides information about how we Process Personal Data when visiting or using our website www.cellpoint.bio (the “Website”).

This Privacy statement also applies to Processing of Personal Data (within the meaning of article 4(1) GDPR, which occurs when you contact Cellpoint through, or by using the information published on, this Website.

3. PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA WHEN CONTACTING US VIA OUR WEBSITE

If you contact us by e-mail or via a contact form, the Personal Data provided by you (your e-mail address, and, if provided, your name and your phone number) will be stored by us on the basis of Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR in order to answer your questions, so we are able to best serve you.

4. PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA WHEN VISITING OUR WEBSITE

If you wish to view our Website, we automatically Process metadata on the legal basis of Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR, which is technically necessary for us to display our Website to you and to guarantee stability and security. The metadata is automatically Processed, includes, but is not limited to:

- Your IP address;
- Date and time of your request;
- Content of your request (the requested webpage(s));
- Access status / HTTP status code;
- The amount of data transferred in each request;
- The website from which the request comes;
- Information on your system, such as operating system version, browsers, plug-ins and its language and interface settings.

5. USE OF COOKIES

When you visit our Website, we make limited use of tracking cookies. Cookies are small text-files, automatically placed and stored on your device when visiting our Website, in order to store certain information relating to the user's device.

The only cookies currently placed, are placed when visiting our Contact page for displaying Google Maps. How these cookies are used for Processing Personal Data, is further described under point 6 below. We process these cookies on the legal basis of Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR (consent), by placing them only if you have provided consent for them using the cookie banner shown on the contact page of our Website

Please note that you can allow, block or delete cookies installed on your device by setting the browser options of the browser installed on your device. Please read the help section of your browser carefully to learn more about how to activate the "Private mode" or unlock certain cookies. The map content is transmitted by Google directly to your browser and integrated into the Website by it. We therefore have no influence on the extent of the data collected in this way by Google. To the best of our knowledge, this is at least the following data:

- Date and time of the visit to the website concerned;
- Internet address or URL of the website accessed;
- IP address, the (start) address entered during route planning.

8. DATA SECURITY

GENERAL RIGHTS

We maintain appropriate technical and organisational measures, within the meaning of Art. 32 GDPR, in order to protect the Personal Data you provide to us against loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction. These measures include the protection of our systems using technical measures such as antivirus and firewall technology and policies to ensure that only employees who have a strict need to access your Personal Data will have access to such data.

9. DURATION OF STORAGE

We process your Personal Data no longer than it is necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were Processed.

Any contact details, and other Personal Data you provide us, to enable us to respond to your requests through our website, will be stored for as long as is necessary to respond to your enquiry, but no longer than 2 years.

Log files on our servers are stored for < >.

Please note, your Personal Data can also be stored for longer, if this is provided for by the legal requirements to which we are subject, for example with regard to statutory retention and documentation obligations. In such a case, we will delete or block your Personal Data after the end of the respective requirements.

10. YOUR RIGHTS AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER CONTACT DETAILS

As a data subject, you have the following rights:

- the right to access your Personal Data processed by us (Art. 15 GDPR);
- the right to request the rectification (Art. 16 GDPR) or erasure (Art. 17 GDPR) of your Personal Data;

- the right to request that we restrict the processing of your Personal Data (Art. 18 GDPR);
- the right to object to the further processing of your Personal Data (Art. 21 GDPR);
- the right to transmit your Personal Data to another controller (Art. 20 GDPR);
- the right to not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you (Art. 22 GDPR).

Your right to withdraw consent:

Where the processing of your Personal Data by us is based on consent, you have the right according to Art. 7 GDPR to withdraw that consent without detriment by contacting our Data Protection Officer.

The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. **Please note**, the above rights are only enabled in so far as granted under the GDPR, and in some cases we, by law, are unable and/or not required to grant you all the rights you have requested. If we are unable to (fully) grant you any requested rights, we will tell you and will provide an explanation on the refusal.
